General Information

Parking and Check-in, Thursday and Friday, April 11 and 12, 8:30 am - 5:00 pm

At check-in you will receive a parking hangtag. This allows you to park in any open surface lot that is not designated with a Reserved 24/7 sign (**This does not include lots with gates**, even if the gate is not functioning.)

The hangtag also allows you to park for an unlimited time in the "30 minute only" spaces in the non-gated portion of the Library Parking deck. This deck is located very near Valborg and our offices in Chapell Wilson Hall and is identified by the yellow dot on this map: https://maps.appstate.edu/campus-map/41.

If you plan to park your car for the entire day, the tag also provides one in/out at the Rivers Street Parking Deck https://maps.appstate.edu/campus-map/42.

After parking, please check in at Chapell Wilson Hall (CWH). Beginning at 8:30 am, there will be a check-in table located in the center of the first-floor hallway, just across from the department office (110 Chapell Wilson Hall.) If your arrival will be later in the morning, please go to CWH 110, the main department office, for check-in.
